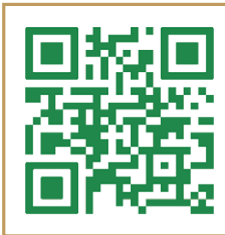

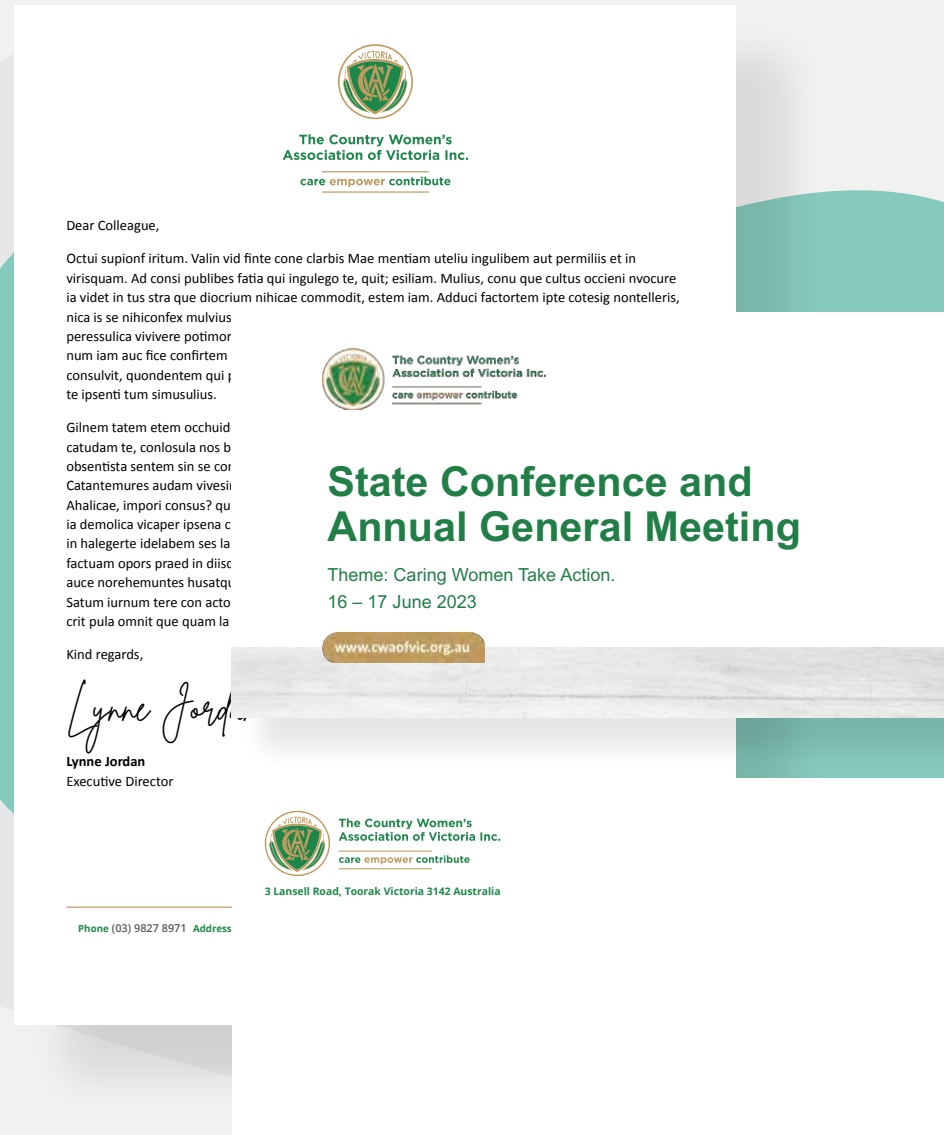

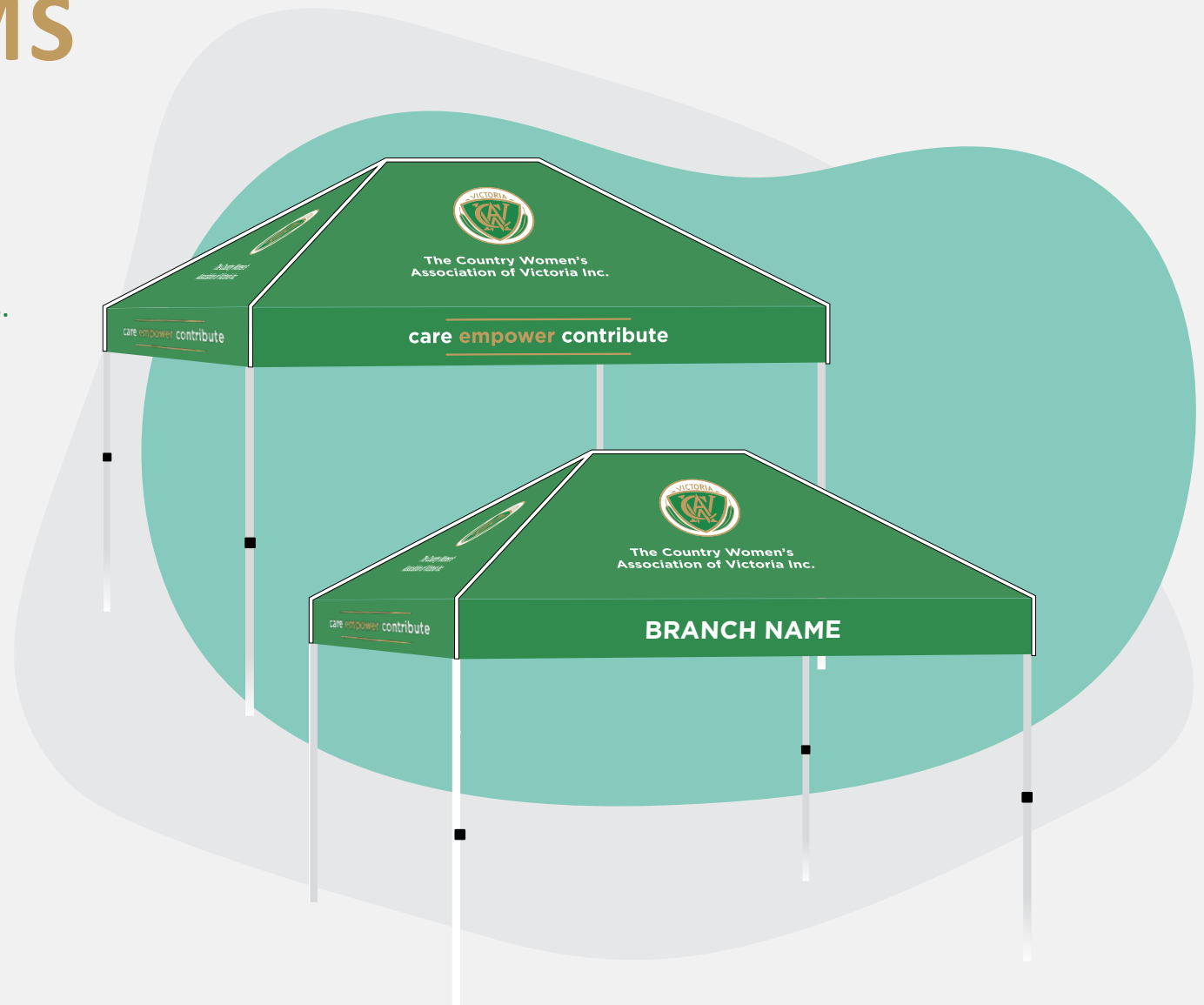
At events, stalls, exhibitions and shows.

SIZE:

3m x 3m

HOW TO USE IT:

- For the generic CWA of Victoria branded gazebo, download all files from the “Generic Artwork Folder” and send to gazebo manufacturer.
- For the Branch or Group branded gazebo, download or “share” the complete “Branch or Group Name Artwork Folder”. This folder includes InDesign files which will allow the gazebo manufacturer to add the Branch or Group name to the artwork using the correct font.



EVENT ITEMS

PULL-UP BANNERS

WHEN TO USE IT:

At events, stalls, exhibitions and shows.

SIZE:

850 x 2200mm (850 model)

HOW TO USE IT:

- For the generic CWA of Victoria branded pull-up banners, download the preferred design file from the “Generic Artwork Folder” and send to banner manufacturer.
- For the Branch or Group branded pull-up banner, download or “share” the “Branch or Group Name Artwork Folder”. This folder includes InDesign files which will allow the banner manufacturer to add the Branch or Group name to the artwork using the correct font.



EVENT ITEMS

TEARDROP FLAGS

WHEN TO USE IT:

At events, stalls, exhibitions and shows.

SIZE:

2m

HOW TO USE IT:

- For the generic CWA of Victoria branded teardrop flag, download all artwork files from the “Generic Artwork Folder” and send to flag manufacturer.
- For the Branch or Group branded teardrop flags, download or “share” the “Branch or Group Name Artwork Folder”. This folder includes InDesign files which will allow the flag manufacturer to add the Branch or Group name to the artwork using the correct font.



SOCIAL MEDIA ONLINE PRINCIPLES

The following Principles outline the values that should be demonstrated in the online social media space both personally or as a CWA of Victoria Branch or Group.

- ✓ Be respectful of all individuals, races, religions and cultures.
- ✓ When in doubt, do not post.
- ✓ If the message would offend your family, friends of work colleagues, do not post.
- ✓ Give credit where credit is due.
- ✓ Know that the comments made on social media platforms are permanent.
- ✓ Don't make comments that are, or could be perceived to be made on behalf of The CWA of Victoria as the Association may be liable.
